Difference between who you are and what you do. Tell the difference... Who are you is defined by the fingerprint of God. What you do is how you utilize the tools that have been given to you. We are after identifying the fingerprint of your uniqueness.

I have seen people who have absolutely no idea who they are. They miss out in living life. They are a person hidden in a cave. They are like Lazarus. They are yet to come out and live life.

Not striving.

Clarity in yourself, purpose, and destiny. God is invested and in your identity.

I would love to break off curses of abandonment and rejection today.

You are supposed to figure it out as you go. 2 practical ways of realizing your identity – seek God and serve.

You were knitted together by His Creativity. You came from His thoughts. You were a byproduct of His mind. You are the apple of His eye.

You came from His breath, spoken by His Voice. You were fashioned out of His design. You were put together according to His design and His plan. You were thought out exactly how you are. Though life put its scars on you, God's design and molecular structure of how you were made is still there.

What Jesus did on the cross through His death and the through the power of His blood redeems that original intent of God over your life which He had in Mind before the foundations of the earth.

Ephesians 1:7 “In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;”

You are a son or a daughter of God.

You are His church.

You are His Co-workmanship.

You are His dwelling place.

You are His bride.

The answer is to find who you are in His presence. The answer is to find yourself in the loving whispers of Who He says you are. The answer is to know the glory of God and allow His presence to illuminate you and cause you to be birthed out of His Glory atmosphere

We need His Glory to find Him and to find ourselves. It's there where you'll see who you are. It's there where you'll have conversations which will define you. It's there where callings are giving, destinies are birthed. It's there where assignments are realized, gifts are activated, anointings are found, minds are made up to serve God. It's there where fears are confronted and decisions to serve are made.

It's there where giants look beatable, valleys look bearable, challenges look scalable, weaknesses look manageable. It's there where flaws look redeemable, mistakes look removed, where life looks livable and you become capable.

It's there where your DNA is found, where you are defined, where the true wiring which makes you is realized and where God says "This is who you are"

God speaks from His eternal habitation. He speaks from his throne. But most of all, He speaks from the perspective of in the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. He speaks from the beginning plans and vision which He had with your original intent. He speaks from your original design and your God given destiny perspective.
